

# Centerville City

Fall Cleanup  
November 16, 2019



Centerville City is offering a fall cleanup service to residents to dispose of household garbage and yard debris. This service is provided on a **pre-pay registration** basis. The City will be picking up boxed, bundled or containerized debris, as well as furniture and appliances, on **Saturday, November 16, beginning at 6:00 a.m.** Items to be picked up must be placed on the curb on Friday evening.

The fee will be **\$20.00 per 3 cubic yards** (a standard pickup-truck load).

The deadline for registration is **Thursday, November 14.**

**Restrictions:**

- All debris must be boxed, bundled, or placed in containers in such a manner that they can be easily picked up.
- Each box, bundle, or container must weigh no more than 75 pounds.
- Only 3 cubic yards (a standard pickup-truck load) will be picked up for each \$20.00 fee.
- **Refrigerators and freezers must have Freon removed**, and a certificate from a licensed technician must be provided.
- **The following will NOT be picked up:** Loose rocks, sod, gravel, bricks, blocks, miscellaneous building materials, tires, car parts, batteries or hazardous/toxic waste.
